




Use Narrator to read and interact with your device



✓ Allow the shortcut key to start Narrator

To turn Narrator off with a touchscreen, tap the Narrator slider, and then double-tap anywhere on the screen.

Press the Windows logo key ■ + Ctrl + Enter to turn Narrator on or

Press the Windows logo key # + Volume Up to turn Narrator on or off on touch devices.



Use color filters


Turn on color filters



  - Word, Outlook, PowerPoint
  - Insert punctuation
- Speech Recognition
  - Windows + Ctrl + S
  - Ease of Access Speech
  - Control your computer/device with only your voice

## Physical

- Mouse keys Use the number pad to move the cursor
- Sticky Keys one key press keyboard shortcuts
- Filter Keys ignore brief or repeated keystrokes

Press one key at a time for keyboard shortcuts


